The annual flag-ship event of the finance club FinDs, Financia was held online on 5th Feb 2022 by the members of the club FinDs of DSIMS & DSGS. Eminent speakers from outstanding industry background were invited to discuss and enlighten the students about the financial markets and share their experiences. The theme for this year was 'Financial Market in Post Covid Times'. The finance students of DSIMS-DSGS hosted and participated in the conclave wholeheartedly.

The event began by Dr. Nehal Joshipura's inaugural speech. She deliberated about how Covid-19 affected the markets globally. She further proposed the theory of overreaction by mentioning how the markets had fallen by 20%-30% globally, but had bounced back within six months. She concluded with a note on behavioral finance. Inaugural speech was followed by the addresses of Director - DSIMS, Dr. C. Babu and Dr. Sarita Vichore, the director - DSGS.

The first speaker for the event was Dr. Paritosh Basu. He is a full-time senior professor at NMIMS, and has done his PhD from Calcutta university. During his tenure at industry, he has worked as Group Controller Essar, CFO RCOM. He deciphered the mega-trends in a post-Covid world and opened up perspectives on leveraging digital technology for business and leadership. He insisted that students take digital global transformation most earnestly.

The second speaker, Devesh Kumar is the Vice Chairman - Research and Capital Market at InCred Capital. He gave a lucid explanation of how technology is adapting to the requirement of the times and how Covid has helped us adapt to technology. He concluded by saying how Covid won't seem like a disrupter in the future, but a tool to make us and the markets transform.

The third speaker, Rohit Agrawal, is the head of Public Sector and Government Undertakings at RBL Bank Ltd. He gave practical insights into how industry and various sectors are coping with the challenges of the pandemic and elaborated on the steps taken by people to cope with the new normal. He spoke about how badly the people in the informal sector were affected, and also how the small businesses suffered.

The fourth speaker, Mayur Joshi, is the head of Product & Initiatives at Yes Securities Ltd. He gave insights into the nature of functioning of markets over decades and explained how the paradigm has shifted over a period of time, leading us to where we are today. He emphasized how tectonic shifts were led by fintech. Moreover, how these were fueled by the work from home culture, and the cheap and accessible internet available today.

The fifth speaker for the event was Mr. Kuldeep Sikarwar. He is the Principal Partner of Private Wealth Management at Edelweiss Broking Limited. He spoke about how our working ecosystem has changed and adapted to a post-Covid world and gave pointers on how to generate efficiencies.

The two days on site visit was scheduled by NAAC after successful submission of Selfstudy report SSR and later Data Verification and Validation (DVV) The onsite visit by NAAC peer team was comprehensive and detailed. The day one of the visit started with a guard of honour given to NAAC peer team members by NCC student committee of Ghanshyamdas Saraf College followed by a welcome address Director **DSIMS** bv the The team members started the audit with a detailed presentation by the Director and IQAC. Thereafter other important criteria stakeholders such as placement cell ,Institutional social responsibility (ISR cell) made presentations before the NAAC team.

The second half of the day was followed by a library visit and interaction with various stakeholders parents, alumni, current batch students, teaching and non-teaching staff. On the second day, the NAAC peer team visited various other departments such as Directors office, Examination Cell, Administration Office where they interacted with respective stakeholders and carefully checked and verified all the supporting documents submitted alongwith SSR. The NAAC peer team took a campus tour on the latter half of the second day. After detailed report writing, the exit meeting was called for in presence of all teaching and non-teaching staff.

During the Exit meeting, the NAAC Peer Team Chairman appreciated the institute for its various unique initiatives and also dedicated and disciplined staff. The members of the team expressed their happiness and satisfaction about the performance of the

college. They also suggested a few necessary steps for improvement for future development of the Institution which were appreciated and taken as positive feedback by the Director DSIMS.

On 28th February cumulative result of onsite visit and SSR was declared on NAAC portal and DSIMS was awarded with NAAC accreditation.
